SAO Finds Texas' Supplemental Pay for Law Enforcement Officers is Not Keeping Pace with Peer Agencies

Background: In its biennial review of the seven largest local law enforcement agencies in Texas, the State Auditor's Office (SAO) noted that the state's supplemental pay for education, certification, and bilingual skills for employees in Salary Schedule C (state law enforcement officers) is also not keeping pace with peer agency officers.

Who is Impacted: 5,244 law enforcement officers across six (6) state agencies: DPS 78.8%; Parks and Wildlife 10.1%; Alcoholic Beverage Commission 4.3%; AG 3.8%; TDCJ 2.6%; and TDI 0.4%.

What is the Current Supplemental Pay for Texas Law Enforcement Officers?

- Education Pay Pay that can be earned by completing a college degree at an associate's, bachelor's, or master's level.
- Certification Pay Pay that can be earned by meeting the Commission on Law Enforcement's proficiency requirements to obtain an intermediate, advanced, or master's certification.
- Bilingual Skills Pay Pay that can be earned by having the ability to speak a language other than English.
