



AgSu how to wear.

The AGSU Wear Guide 2024 provides a comprehensive visual representation of uniform placement for the AGSU, ASU, Class B, and ACU, including badge arrangement by group categories. It also includes a segment from FM 3-21.5 on Drill and Ceremonies, a detailed guide for conducting in-ranks inspections, and a color-coded ribbon chart displaying the sequence of Army Ribbons. The guide aims to simplify uniform standards without the need to consult extensive regulations.
