Hey everyone! I hope you had an amazing weekend! As for me, I got a sneak peek of spring yesterday and it was fantastic! It's that time of year when Derby season is just around the corner. Speaking of which, I finally got to share this board game with you all that we played on Derby Day last year. It's called Horse Racing and it's super fun! You can play it as a family-friendly activity or even use it as a kids' party game without betting. The whole thing takes about 3 minutes per player, so it's perfect for in-between races or just having some friendly competition. To make this game, you'll need: * White foam board * Black Sharpie * Long ruler * Printables (just right-click and save to your computer) * Piece of white foam board * 6 die horse printables or jockey silks (cut out and colored in) * 6 small red solo cups for game pieces Here's how you put it together: 1. Lay the game on your foam board, including the starting line, finish line, winners' circle, and rule card. 2. Draw six lines for the "track" using a pencil and ruler. 3. Go over the pencil marks with a Sharpie. 4. Glue on all the printables. 5. Cut out and color the jockey silks or horses and attach them to mini solo cups that are upside down (your game pieces). Now you're ready to play! I hope this gives you enough time to make it for Derby Day this year. Let me know if you have any questions. Have a great day! Starting the Game: Deal the remaining cards to players. The first player rolls the dice, and the corresponding horse moves to the scratched section. Players with matching cards discard their cards and pay 5-20 cents into the pot, increasing by 5 cents per roll. This continues until four horses are scratched, then the race begins. Players take turns rolling the dice, paying or advancing based on the result. The game ends when a horse crosses the finish line, and the pot is split among winning players. Make sure it's wide enough for pieces to fit comfortably around each turn. Customize your track by adding obstacles like gateways, jumps, and small barriers. Mark starting spaces for players in a circle or designated spot, using felt-tipped markers. Add random dots on the track for events and obstacles, such as "Lose one lap" or "Advance One Spot." Prepare game cards with specific events and consequences, color-coded to each player's start space. Make die pieces from numbered cardboard circles stacked together and taped onto a larger cube. Assemble all materials near the playing area and review the rules with players before starting gameplay.
