


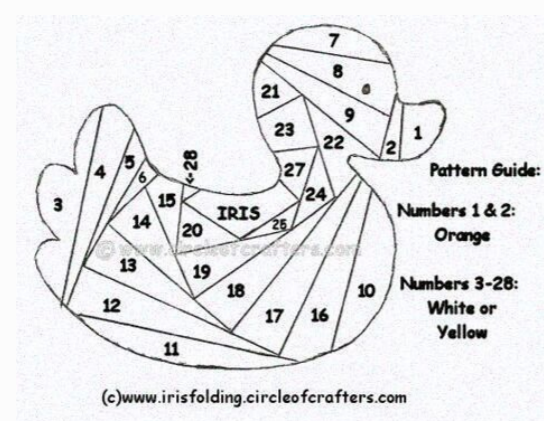

The square iris template can be downloaded in PDF format. **Triangle Iris Folding:** For a triangle iris, six strips of each of the three colors are needed. Assign the strips to numbers 1 to 15 in sequence. The triangle template is also provided in PDF format. After selecting and cutting out your pattern, secure it to your workspace with tape to begin folding. This process adds depth and creativity to your paper crafts. To ensure your iris folding project remains stable, affix your template atop the pattern, aligning the cutout with the pattern's shape. Secure it with minimal masking tape on the white card to leave ample space for attaching your colored paper strips. For added convenience during the folding process, you might color the pattern's segments to correspond with the guide. 1) **Preparing Paper Strips:** Select thin paper like colored paper, gift wrap, or wide florist ribbon for your iris folding strips. Secure it with adhesive tape to the white card, trimming any excess later. Continue this method with 'Number 2' and subsequent numbers, adhering the strips in numerical sequence. Overlap tape on previously placed strips if necessary, but keep it within the white card's borders.
