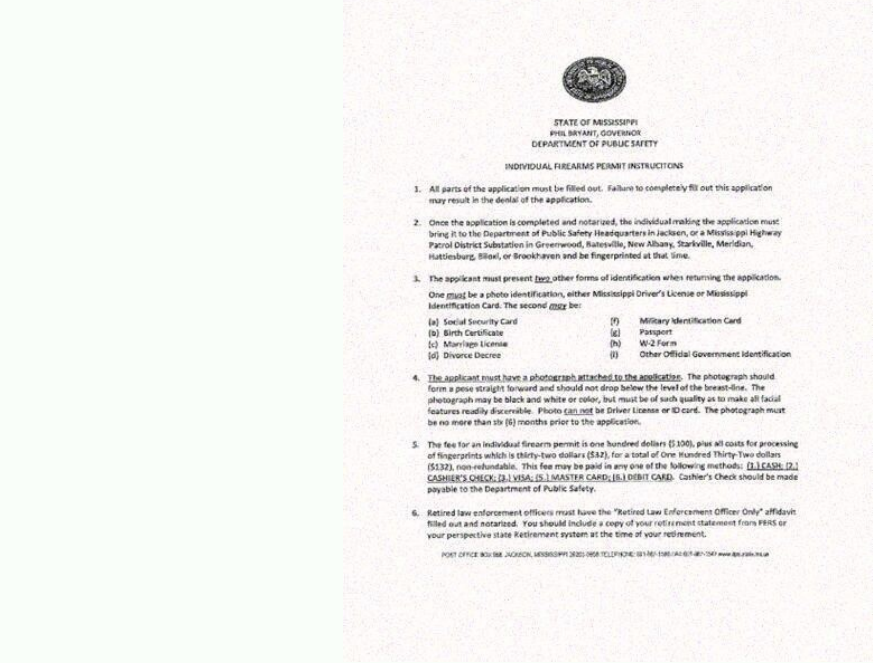

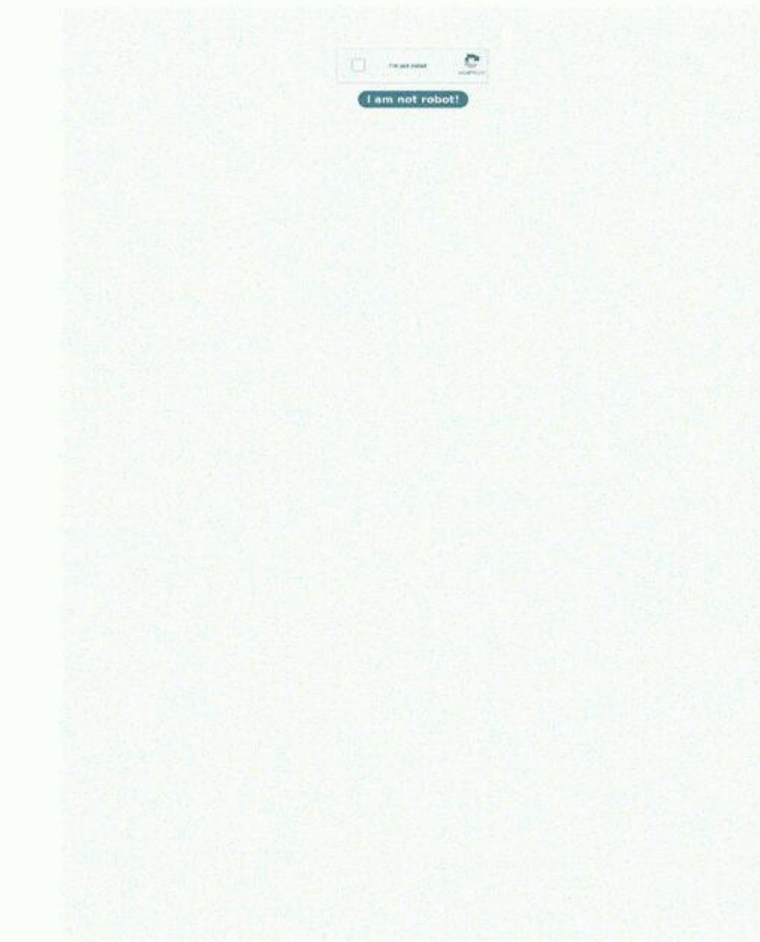

Important notes: * Renewal should be done at least 90 days before the expiration date. * Expired permits can still be renewed, but may incur late fees. * Name or address changes require updates with the Department of Public Safety before renewing your permit.
