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

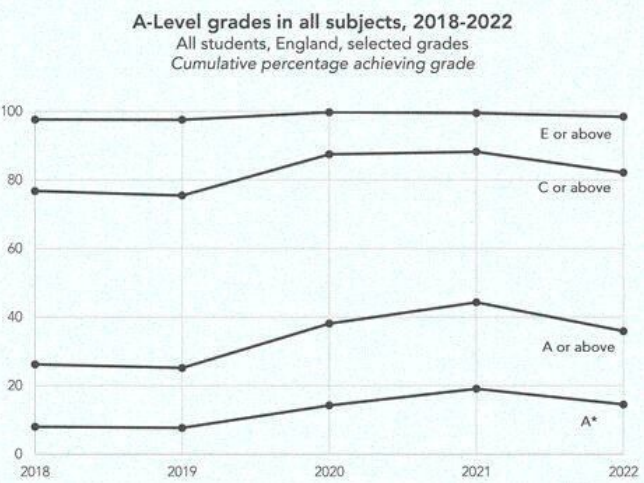

Curriculum, Examinations & Assessment. In Wales, the Welsh Joint Education Committee (WJEC) administers exams under its own brand and Eduqas. Grade boundaries are based on the difficulty of each exam, ensuring that students are not unfairly penalized for challenging exams.
