

# CBSA Assessment and ACTION REQUIRED BEFORE MAY 2024! REGISTER YOUR BUSINESS IN THE CARM CLIENT PORTAL

Under the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) Assessment and Revenue Management (CARM) project all commercial importers (resident and non) must register their business in the CBSA CARM Client Portal PRIOR to MAY 2024. In addition to registering your business, you will also need to delegate authority to any approved representatives in your CARM client portal account and post Release Prior to Payment (RPP) Surety bond.

#### How to Register for the CARM Client Portal

1. Go to the CBSA CARM homepage at

https://ccp-pcc.cbsa-asfc.cloud-nuage.canada.ca/en/auth/login

and select Log into the CARM Client Portal

- CE Select how you would like to access the ACARM client portal, either via Sign-In Partner Aor GCKey (GCKey is preferred)
- HÈ If you already have a GCKEY then continue toÁ sign in. If you do not have GCKEY, then selectÁ "sign up" on right hand side of the Welcome toÁ GCKEY screen and follow the prompts.
- I É Once you have your GCKEY, each time youÁ sign in you will be asked to verify your emailÁ via multi-step authentication. Fill in your emailÁ address and enter the code that is emailed toÁ you. Once complete, you can then navigate toÁ the CARM Client Portal. You must read andÁ accept the terms/conditions of use each timeÁ you log in.

  Î E You will then need to create your personalÁ
  profile (remember the person who registersÁhe
  business automatically becomes the BAMBusiness Account Manager in CARM for yourÁ
  business, so should be a Controller/CFO orÁ
  owner. Additional BAM's can be added later,Á
  and you should have at least 2). Make sureÁ
  you subscribe to email notifications whenÁ
  setting up your profile.
- Î È Register your Business. You will need to inputÁ the 9 digit Business Number for your companyÁ and your RM Import/Export account extensionÁ (IE: RM0001) and select that you authorizedÁ person to register the business.
- İ Enter the Legal Business Name and Address.Á
  If system does not accept your answers thenÁ
  the legal name/address on file with the CBSAÁ
  does not match what you are inputting.Á
  Information must match exact, includingÁ
  punctuation. You will need to verify yourÁ
  information with the CBSA prior to continuing.
- Ì È Once above accepted, you will be required to A select/answer some financial affinity Aquestions.
- JÈ Last step, you will be asked to review andÁ confirm that all information entered is correct.

## How to Delegate Authority in the Portal

- When logged into the CARM Client Portal on your homepage, select "Setup my portal"
- 2. Select "Manage my business relationships"
- 3. Select "Received Requests"
- 4. Select the "Approve" beside the authorized requestor.
- 5. Select "All Programs"
- 6. Select "Business Management"
- 7. Business Settings >Transaction Visibility Rules>Check all 3
- 8. Review details and select approve
- 9. Repeat the process for any new additions

## Release Prior to Payment (RPP) Requirement

As of March 2, 2023 it is heavily implied from the CBSA that importers who are registered in the CARM Client Portal, PRIOR to MAY 2024 will have a 180 day grace period to have a Release Prior to Payment (RPP) Bond in place. Importers not registered in the portal prior to October may suffer serious delays as a result. Please do not delay, get your business registered prior to this deadline to take advantage of any relief and make sure that you are ready for this change that is coming. Further information on obtaining the RPP Bond will follow as it becomes available.
