Objective: be the first player to complete a sequence of five chips in a row Players strategically place chips, use special cards to block opponents and form own sequences Setup: game board placed in center; playing cards shuffled and dealt to each player Turns: played clockwise, two steps per turn, play card from hand, place chip on corresponding space Special Cards: Jack removes opponent's chip, Queen blocks sequence, King acts as wild card These special cards add strategic element to the game The game requires strategic planning and execution through the building of sequences by each player. Players need to tactically position their chips and use special cards at optimal moments to enhance their chances of success. In team games, effective communication and cooperation can significantly boost a team's efficiency in creating sequences and ultimately securing wins.
