When using the Ergobaby™ carrier, always keep your child securely positioned and never leave them unattended. Babies must weigh between 7 lbs (3.2 kg) and 45 lbs (20 kg), and face towards you until they can hold their head upright. Ensure proper placement of the baby in the product, including leg positioning. Do not strap the baby too tight against your body, allow room for head movement, and keep the baby's face free from obstructions at all times. Do not let the baby sleep in the front outward-facing carry position, and always monitor their mouth and nose to ensure they are unobstructed. Take care when bending or leaning forward or sideways as your balance may be affected by your movement and that of your child. Never use a soft carrier while engaging in activities such as cooking and cleaning which involve a heat source or exposure to chemicals. Also, never wear a soft carrier while driving or being a passenger in a vehicle. Babies under 4 months are at greatest risk of suffocation, so always be aware of their airway clearance and breathing. Premature infants, infants with respiratory problems, and those under 4 months require extra caution when using the Ergobaby™ carrier. Only carry one child at a time, and never use/wear more than one carrier at a time to prevent accidents. When using a baby carrier, ensure your little one's head is held high and supported by the neck cushion until they develop strong neck control. Regularly check their arms, legs, and feet to prevent constrictions from the carrier. After nursing or bottle feeding, wait about 30 minutes before putting the carrier on to aid digestion. The baby should be able to move their head freely without pressing their face against your body, and always ensure there's enough opening for air to pass through when using the hood. Be mindful of loose buckles and straps that could catch the baby's fingers or cause injury. Always fasten the buckles properly when not in use, keep the carrier away from children, and inspect it regularly for wear and damage. Never use a damaged carrier, and only use approved positions (front, back, and hip carry) once your baby has shown strong head control. When learning to place the baby in the carrier, do so over a bed with assistance from another adult, and take care when using the back carry position. Wear the carrier waist belt higher for smaller babies or adults with longer torsos, and don't use it unless you're confident and comfortable with its safety features. If you develop shoulder, back, or neck problems while using the carrier, discontinue its use and consult a medical professional. If your baby shows signs of discomfort while being carried, take a break until they can be carried without distress. The correct materials for the child's outfit should be checked.
