I'm experiencing issues with Ryzen Master after upgrading to my new CPU. After installing the 5800X, Ryzen Master wouldn't install properly, and it would keep thinking that the program is still installed even after uninstalling it and running a clean-up tool. I've tried reinstalling the latest version, but it keeps failing to unpack. My system's up-to-date, and I'm running the latest BIOS. I previously had no issues with my 3600 CPU on this same motherboard, so I'm stumped. I get an error message when trying to use Ryzen Master: "overclocking feature is not supported by processor." I have a Ryzen 5 3600 CPU, Asus B350 gaming-f motherboard, and BIOS version 4801. This has me scratching my head, as my previous R5 1600 worked fine with Ryzen Master. Has anyone else encountered this problem? The only change here is the new processor.
