## Gst admission circular 2025

Examinations in 2023 or 2024 are acceptable for SSC or equivalent exams from 2020, 2021, or 2022. Second-year applicants can apply for the 2024-2025 admission cycle. The eligibility criteria varies by unit: - Science: Minimum GPA of 3.50 in both SSC and HSC (including the fourth subject), with a combined GPA of at least 8.00 (7.50 for specific cases). - Humanities: A minimum GPA of 3.00 in both SSC and HSC (including the fourth subject) with a combined GPA of at least 6.00. - Commerce: A minimum GPA of 3.00 in both SSC and HSC (including the fourth subject) with a combined GPA of at least 6.50. For international candidates, specific requirements apply. - O-Level (IGCSE): Passed at least five subjects with B grades in three subjects. - A-Level (IAL): Passed at least three subjects with B grades in two subjects. The GST admission test schedule for 2025 is as follows: - April 25, 2025 (Friday) 11:00 AM 12:00 PM (Unit C) - May 2, 2025 (Friday) 11:00 AM 12:00 PM (Unit B) - May 9, 2025 (Friday) 11:00 AM 12:00 PM (Unit A) - May 9, 2025 (Friday) 3:30 PM 4:30 PM (Architecture Practical Drawing Test) To apply for admission, candidates must submit the application form online through the official website by March 15, 2025. The standard application fee is 1500 BDT, with an additional 500 BDT required for Architecture programs. To complete the application form, you'll need to pay the fee. The standard fee is 1500 BDT, plus 500 BDT if applicable for Architecture. You can make payments through mobile banking (bKash, Nagad, Rocket), online banking, debit cards, credit cards, or other available methods as specified on the payment page. After successful payment, you'll receive a confirmation message with your application ID and essential details. Ensure both form submission and fee payment are complete before the deadline. Incomplete applications without payment verification won't be processed. The GST Admission 2025 unites 19 public universities in Bangladesh under a single admission system. Admit cards will be available for download from April 2025 until your scheduled test date. To obtain your admit card, visit the official website [gstadmission.ac.bd](http://gstadmission.ac.bd). Print two color copies on A4 size offset paper and bring them to the examination center on test day. The GST Admission Result 2025 marks the final hurdle in securing admission to your chosen universities. To access your results, contact the GST Admission Authority through their official website's helpline immediately if you face any issues with downloading your admit card. The test results will determine your eligibility for admission based on your performance in one of three units: A (Science), B (Humanities), or C (Business). The tests are scheduled across 19 centers nationwide at specific unit-specific dates, including May 9 for Science and April 25 for Business. The GST Admission Test follows an MCQ format with a total of 100 marks. Results will be announced promptly, typically within seven days after each unit's test completion, allowing you to proceed without unnecessary delays. The system divides candidates into three units based on their academic backgrounds and requires taking the corresponding admission test for HSC/equivalent exam groups. Additionally, you can apply for related subjects in other units if you meet specific university conditions, provided you pass the corresponding unit's test. The GST Admission Test syllabus follows the HSC 2024 curriculum as prescribed by the National Curriculum and Textbook Board, Bangladesh. Your HSC preparation serves as an excellent foundation for the test. After passing the test, your final admission process will be completed in two steps. If you're on the merit list, you'll need to fill out a final application for your desired universities. Eligible candidates will then gain access to a centralized application system to apply to multiple universities simultaneously. The GST Admission Circular for 2025 was published on February 25, 2025, marking the start of the application period from March 5 to March 15, 2025. The exams are divided into three units based on academic backgrounds: A (Science), B (Humanities), and C (Business). Each test follows a 100-mark MCQ format with a 30-mark passing threshold. Candidates can download their GST Admit Card through the [gstadmission.ac.bd](http://gstadmission.ac.bd) website, which has been released for all units. The admit card can be downloaded by logging in with Application ID and Password, and must be printed in color. The Integrated Admission Test Authority has announced the schedule for the GST Admission Test, which will be conducted in three phases for different units. The test dates are as follows: Science (A-Unit) - May 9, 2025; Humanities (B-Unit) - May 2, 2025; and Business Studies (C-Unit) - April 25, 2025. The testing process will begin on April 27, with the science unit test scheduled for this date. The humanities unit test will take place on May 3, while the commerce unit test will occur on May 10, 2025. Candidates can access their detailed seat plans before the admission test through the official website or by SMS. However, it is crucial to note that the center selected during the application process must be used for the admission test. You must pay the processing fee within 72 hours of submitting your application; otherwise, it will be invalid. The results for the A-Unit entrance exam will be published on May 13, 2025. Event dates are as follows: Application Start - March 5, 2025; Application Deadline - March 17, 2025 (extended); Payment Last Date - March 17, 2025; Admit Card Download - April 5, 2025; Admission Test Dates - April 25, May 2, and May 9. The GST Admission Test 2025 for 19 universities will be held as scheduled. Only students who passed SSC/Equivalent in 2020, 2021, and 2022, and HSC/Equivalent, Diploma-in-Commerce, HSC (Vocational), under Bangladesh Technical Education Board, A Level, or other equivalent examinations approved by the Equivalence Determination Committee in 2022 and 2023 will be eligible to apply for admission. Students who passed HSC/Equivalent from Science, Arts, or Business Studies groups can apply for Units A, B, and C, respectively, subject to eligibility. The eligibility criteria for unit-based applications are as follows: Unit A (Science) - applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.50 in both SSC/Equivalent and HSC/Equivalent examinations (including the 4th subject) with a total GPA of at least 8.00; Unit B (Humanities) - applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.00 in both SSC/Equivalent and HSC/Equivalent examinations (including the 4th subject) with a total GPA of at least 6.00; Unit C (Business Studies) - applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.00 in both SSC/Equivalent and HSC/Equivalent examinations (including the 4th subject) with a total GPA of at least 6.50. In the case of GCE, candidates must pass in 5 subjects, including at least 3 subjects with B grades in ICSE (O Level) examination, and pass in 3 subjects, including at least 2 subjects with B grades in IAL (A-Level) examination. In this case, the application must be made through online upload of the Marksheet and approval by the Equivalence and Eligibility Determination Committee. Admission applications to 19 universities under the GST Admission System started on March 5, 2025. The last date of application is March 15, 2025. GST admission form can be filled out through [gstadmission.ac.bd](http://gstadmission.ac.bd) website. Candidates must submit a selfie while applying, and pay Tk 1500 as application fee through mobile or online banking at the time of application. They need to choose the test center name where they want to appear in the admission test. Detailed instructions for GST application are available on the website. One center should be selected at the time of primary application, and candidates must attend the admission test at that designated center. Exam centers cannot be changed. Admission test centers include Islamic University, Kushtia, Mawlana Bhashani Science and Technology University, Tangail, Patuakhali Science and Technology University, among others. The exam center can not be change. GST admit cards will be released after online application and separate admit cards for each unit are available. Admit cards can be downloaded using the application ID and password on the GST Admission System website. The deadline to download admit card is notified separately. Usually, result is published within 72 hours of admission test completion. To apply for a university subject to eligibility, students must appear in the GST Admission Test and score at least 30 marks. A minimum of 0.25 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.
