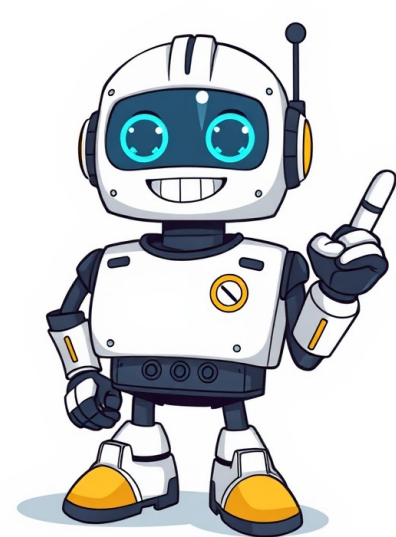

I'd certainly be interested in joining, as I've been trying to report this one bad actor to the Roblox mods/DevRel for some time and he's not only not been banned after years, but he's also since gotten verified too. It'd be cool if you could invite you-know-who to this community as well. RbxRocketMan: We want to ensure we are continually getting feedback from this community, and in particular striking the right balance between keeping the community safe and imposing limitations that could unfairly take down a creator's experience. Make staff members at Roblox use this devforum then and utilize the Community Feedback Program. I've applied three times and haven't gotten in because I'm not a popular developer. That's a problem. And, if you weren't here in 2019, you don't have access to Feature Requests. We got bug reports, and I know people are working on it, but that means you fundamentally cannot listen to us. The appeals and support forms have too many copy-and-paste like responses that are unhelpful. None of that is mentioned here. RbxRocketMan: we are developing a Community Safety Council that will be made up of members from our creator community. Is that the thing where you added kids to the council? Respectfully, I saw that as a PR thing and unhelpful. I know Roblox internally. I've researched it for 6 years now heavily. Every tech talk, networking with staff, trying bugs and giving feedback through the only channels I could. Hear me when I say the top-down structure needs a look. You have passionate staff who work hard, and I don't think they're the problem. More responsibility and humility from the top would help. It's difficult to build safety at this scale, but you have people to help. And I don't mean more AI/ML. The company is shifting more towards AI and the employees are unfortunately reflecting that sometimes by taking in feedback with AI. It's disrespectful. RbxRocketMan: Blocking users under 17 from Social Hangouts with private spaces and experiences primarily set in private spaces Great, children can't join experiences with private spaces made for adults anymore. But predators can still join experiences primarily made for children, communicate with them, and also wear bypassed UGC to expose them to inappropriate content. If anything, children under 13 should have entirely separate text channels than adults. Most adults don't have any business talking to children, and children don't have any reason to be talking to random adults either. RbxRocketMan: Unrated experiences will be unavailable for all users So bad actors will do the questionnaire, probably lie, and make sure their game reaches as many people as possible before it gets deleted entirely too late. Then re-upload it under a different account. This will definitely stop the predator problem, especially considering that Roblox's age verification systems are primarily AI-based, which as we know, are completely infallible and NEVER make mistakes. Give yourself a well-earned pat on the back for this one and sit back and relax! You've earned it buddy! 8 Likes social hangouts in private spaces in my opinion should be banned entirely as many users do many erotic roleplays in those selected experiences. however, if you really are against banning these games, the best solution would be to raise the minimum age from 17 to 18. the age 17 is still recognized as being a "minor" in the united states, and 17 year old users can still be attacked and assaulted by predators. i'd also recommend to take down social hangouts if they are not moderated properly and allow actions that are against the terms of use. finally, i would STRONGLY recommend you work with creators and influencers (ex: schlep) that want to help roblox moderation to help moderate the platform.
